CONNECT

Spend some time checking in. What are highs and lows since you last met? How can your group members pray for and support each other this week?

GROW

- Where have you experienced "confirmation bias"—seeking to confirm what we already believe? Angie gave both simple examples of red trees or a blue car, as well as today's political landscape. If you were honest, how have you reinforced what you are looking for at times?
- Do you think divisions are reinforced over commonalities, more often than not? Why is that so easy to do?
- Read [Luke 7:36-49](#).
- How have you seen this story from Luke play out in your life? How would you define "truly seeing"? Why is it easier to see where we are divided rather than what we have in common?
- This week, look around and reflect with intention: *What am I seeing? Who am I seeing? Am I seeing the person or the party?*
