CONNECT

Spend some time checking in. What are highs and lows since you last met? How can your group members pray for and support each other this week?

GROW

- In the midst of making a big decision, have you found yourself asking, "God, will you send a sign?" What happens when there is no clear direction? There's a common view that if we somehow make the "right" choices we'll stay on God's path. Why is this approach easiest, although the most limiting in our understanding of God?

- As a group, talk about any big upcoming decisions you're facing in this year like no other. Remind one another that God is with you in those decisions, no matter what you choose, and no matter what happens.
