## CONNECT

Spend some time checking in. What are highs and lows since you last met? How can your group members pray for and support each other this week?

## GROW

- Think about the song "He's Got the Whole World in His Hands." What message does it send? Has that message ever been called into question for you? Why or why not?
- What uncertainty keeps you up at night? Think to a pivotal time in your life where things seemed uncertain. How do you typically respond to uncertainty?
- Read about Jesus' disciples at the Last Supper: [Mark 14:12-26](#). What starts out as normal plans for the Passover, turns into something different for those disciples. What sticks out to you?
- Why do we assume that God is absent when things are uncertain or don't go our way?
- What does it mean to you that God's greatest hope is to be known in the midst of our messes or uncertainty?

## PRAY

God, it doesn't always feel like you've got the whole world in your hands. We see pain, suffering, and so much uncertainty all around us. But remind us, God, that you show up when things seem most broken. Thank you for your presence, even when we least expect it. We may only see the messiness of the world, but you've *still* got us in your hands. Amen.
